Details

The Sail Training Week seeks to introduce children, aged 8 and over, to sailing and through this to encourage their interest in waterborne sports and activities. The RMYC has run a very successful series of courses in the past and I hope that you will feel able to give us your continuing support.

The aim is to teach children between 8 and 14 years of age RYA Start Sailing Stages 1, 2, 3 and 4 using a range of single-handed and two-handed dinghies. Sailing instruction will be carried out in **either** morning or afternoon sessions. A seamanship module will be available for children who have completed Stage 4. The fee for 2018 is the same as the last three years, at £160 per child.

The minimum age is 8 years of age in line with RYA guidance and to allow the children to gain maximum benefit from the training.

CHILDREN UNDER 8 WILL NOT BE COVERED UNDER CLUB INSURANCE AND WILL BE TURNED AWAY.

Members who would like their children or young relatives (who must be Cadet or Family Unit members of the Club) to participate are asked to return an Application Form (attached) by Tuesday 29th May 2018 at the latest.

If the child or young relative are not already a Cadet or Family Member of the RMYC, a membership application is required to be completed along with cadet subscriptions of £35.00 for 2018. Membership applications are available from the office.

Applicants for RYA Stage 3 or 4 should be aware that if they have not undertaken any training or gained additional experience since the 2017 STW course that they will be unlikely to achieve the required standard in one year.

CHILDREN'S POWERBOAT LEVEL 1 COURSES

30th July – 3rd August 2018

Consecutively with the children's sail training week, there will be an opportunity for those children participating in the sail training to undertake RYA Powerboat Level 1 courses. Numbers are limited by availability of instructors and boats (RYA rules only allow 3 pupils per instructor/boat) and the additional cost will be £80 per child to include Powerboat Log Book and Certificate, the same as last year. Minimum age is **8 years**.

- If you wish your child to take part, please tick the appropriate box on the application form.
- RYA Powerboat level 1 provides a practical introduction to boat handling and safety in powerboats. It will be conducted in the Club RIB and other similar planing craft.
- The course consists of two morning or afternoon sessions on the Tuesday and Thursday of STW. Children booked on morning sail training will be programmed on afternoon powerboat and vice versa.
- Suitable clothing and footwear for the conditions is required as well as a correctly fitting buoyancy aid or lifejacket.
- On successful completion of the course, children will be awarded the RYA level 1 certificate. Those between 8 & 11 years will be endorsed "The holder should only use powered craft under the supervision of a responsible adult on board the craft." While those over 11 years will be endorsed "The holder should only use powered craft under the supervision of a responsible adult".

It should be emphasised that places are limited and depending on the response, it may not be possible for all children to be accommodated during this week.
